

Frontline Volunteer Role Description

Responsibilities

- Develop familiarity and fluency with the Centennial Legacy Campaign and how it will benefit your congregation.
- Participate in the training and coaching sessions where needed to learn about the Campaign and how to perform your role.
- Identify potential legacy donors within your congregation using the training and tools provided.
- Approach potential legacy donors from your congregation and have conversations about remembering their church in their will. Training and ongoing coaching provided.
- Make a planned gift or bequest to your congregation, Mission and Service or The United Church of Canada Foundation commensurate with your ability.
- Attend your Regional Campaign Support Forum meetings for trainings and tools.
- Inform your fundraising coach of legacy commitments as you secure them.

You are an ideal Frontline Volunteer candidate if you are:

- Committed to the future of your congregation and of The United Church of Canada.
- A well-respected member of your congregation community known to your members.
- Comfortable with and willing to talk to people in your congregation about remembering our church in their will.
- Have good knowledge of your local congregation and its members.
- Willing to work on securing bequests from members of your congregation over a 1-2 year period.
