Clergy in Training Scholarship

Through the generosity of United Church people, communities of faith, theological schools, General Council, and more, The United Church of Canada Foundation and The Black Clergy Network are pleased to announce the Black Clergy Network Scholarship program.

The program, consisting of three Scholarship streams, is intended to foster and support Black people, United Church Theological Students, and Clergy in The United Church of Canada.

This application is for the ***Clergy in Training Scholarship***, which provides support for theological education students within United Church of Canada-accredited institutions, emphasizing future ministry within the church:

1. The student must be enrolled in a United Church of Canada theological school.

The successful candidate can apply for the scholarship 2 times and receive it 2 times.

The individual maximum amount for applicants is **\$5000**.

5. 500-word essay on your contribution to the Black Community
6. Two Letters of Reference One reference from a person such as a teacher, or a professor from a United Church of Canada institution or an accredited post-secondary program, who has taught you, ideally within the past two years. One reference from a minister who is qualified to evaluate your community involvement and character. Additional references may be requested. All Letters of Reference must be presented on institutional letterhead

Applications may also be expected to participate in an interview with the Black Clergy Network Selection Committee
